

FOREST LAKE STATE PARK--41.5 MILES
(with option of additional 25-30 mile loop through Littleton)

- (0.0) 0.0 L out of Applebrook, going up 115A to Jefferson
- (0.5) 0.5 L in Jefferson onto Rte. 2
- () 1.2 R onto NORTH RD.
- () ~~8.3~~ L at stop in Lancaster on Rte. 3, cross over Israel River
- () 8.4? R on Rte 135
- () 13.5 L at covered bridge (Vt. is just over the bridge!)
[Alternative route for long ride to Littleton: cross through Lunenburg covered bridge, continue south (Rte102?) in Vt. to Gilman and then cross back into NH, continuing south on Rte. 135 into Littleton. Used to be a bike shop at light in Littleton...and and ice cream place 1/4 mile south on 116/18 (ask first).
- () 16.2 L on Rte 142
- () 22.38 Whitefield. (Town green in center, stores, gas station, etc.) Stop at gazebo for lunch or buy lunch and take it to state park.
Continue straight in roughly same direction across the town
- () R on Rte. 116S
- () 25.0 R on Forest Lake Rd. to Forest State Park
- () 27.0 L at fork into Forest State Park . (Entrance fee. Leave bikes by guard.)
Swimming. Changing rooms available.

RETURN:

- (0.0) 0.0 R out of parking lot at Forest State Park by ticket office
- (2.0) 2.0 L on 116N towards Whitefield
- (2.5) 4.56 L at stop on 116N (3/142/116 intersection)
- (0.1) 4.64 R on 116N towards Jefferson (2 big hills and a final steep pitch to Rte 2)
- (8.9) 13.5 R at stop sign onto Rte 2.
- (0.5) 14.0 R on 115A
- (0.5) 14.5 R into Applebrook driveway.

For a longer ride (additional 25-30 miles):

At the 135/142 split before going into Whitefield, continue S on 135 to Littleton, connecting to 116 N, and then L on Forest Lake Rd. before town of Whitefield.
